Boise, Idaho September, 2016 – The Idaho Nonprofit Center has helped nonprofits to succeed since 2001 by bringing nonprofit organizations together to collaborate, network, build awareness, and share best practices and resources through fundraisers, training meetings and other events throughout each year.

Idaho Gives is the Center's largest program designed to support non-profits across the state. In addition to raising over 2.3MM since its inception in 2013. New Idaho Nonprofit Center Executive Director Amy Little reports that the Idaho Gives event has grown each year. Donors have climbed from 6,192 in 2013 to over 8,900 in 2015, and average donations have increased from \$57 to \$70 over the past two years.

The Idaho Nonprofit Center is a member of the national Council of Nonprofits and is chaired by board members and CEO's of nonprofit organizations throughout Idaho. It represents over 5,500 registered charitable nonprofit organizations. The Center is represented by over 50,000 nonprofit employees and 425,000 volunteers.
